- The acquisition strengthens Thrive's financial services expertise across the Northeast with a strong and talented roster of engineering professionals










Enterprise Value / LTM Revenue




Enterprise Value / LTM EBITDA



LTM Revenue Growth




LTM Gross & EBITDA Margin*
