- The acquisition bolsters NTT's AWS, DevOps, and Agile development capabilities and its ability to drive digital services for its clients






- Accenture, a global provider of consulting, technology and outsourcing services worldwide, acquired Clarity Insights, a US-based provider

 ability to meet the demand for AI, analytics and automation solutions






Enterprise Value / LTM Revenue




Enterprise Value / LTM EBITDA



LTM Revenue Growth




LTM Gross & EBITDA Margin*
